This course is designed specifically for those students who are serious about pursuing a career in medicine, dentistry or veterinary science with the intention of applying to university in September 2022 or 2023. The course offers guidance on the application processes, organising appropriate work and voluntary experience, and preparing students for interviews by discussing important topics such as professionalism, ethics, aptitude tests (BMAT/UCAT for medics) critical thinking and problem-solving skills. The aim is to enable students to produce a targeted personal statement for their UCAS application. As part of the Enrichment programme, the LPGS Careers advisor, Mrs Hayden will seek to organise a mentorship programme with a practising doctor, dentist or veterinary surgeon, which students are expected to attend in addition to the timetabled enrichment lessons. The course requires that students complete 3 assignments early in the programme to enable them to continue with the course in the spring and summer terms. All applicants are required to apply for it by submitting a written application to Dr Jennings of no more than 500 words outlining why they should be considered for the course; including their reasons for wanting to do it, what preparation they have done so far in researching their chosen prospective career and whether they have done or applied for relevant work or voluntary experience. Please note that Year 12 applicants will be prioritised.

Topics include: the big bang, formation of the solar system, dinosaurs, human evolution. Students may add their own topics (ie the greeks, invention of writing, beginning of agriculture; or anything they are interested in that fits with the development of life in our universe. The teacher will show students how to make books and give brief talks on the areas of interest (big bang, dinosaurs etc). The students will research, make books and add content.
