Wednesday 9th December 2020	Live Q & A event about how we get exceptional results and support you through your life in the Sixth Form
Open Evening – subject market place (dependent upon COVID R-rate and Government advice)	
Monday 22nd February 2021	Wave 1 application deadline
Monday 8th March 2021 to Friday 19th March 2021	Sixth form interviews
Monday 19th April 2021	Wave 2 application deadline
Monday 3rd May 2021 to Friday 14th May 2021	Sixth form interviews
Friday 25th June 2021	Sixth Form induction days (Dependent upon COVID R-rate and government advice)
Friday 27th August 2021	Enrolment day (dependent upon announcements about when examination results will be released). 8-9am Wave 1 applicants; 9-10am Wave 2 applicants

Due to the exceptional results that LPGS students have achieved in the last few years, we were significantly over-subscribed for some courses. Therefore we will be staggering enrolment and invitation to enrolment will depend upon whether you applied in time for the 1st or 2nd deadline. We encourage application up to and including the day of enrolment in August, because occasionally students who apply, don't make the entry requirements, or indeed, some change their minds about which courses to study.
