**SUCCESS CRITERIA**

- a) 97% of students make expected progress and 50% make more than expected progress
- b) Work scrutinies and monitoring demonstrate progress in 80% of students' learning outcomes through responses to teacher feedback
- c) Student surveys show that 80% of students believe their confidence has developed
